

! Please consider the following points and rules at all times during your stay in the "Haus Montana"!

- The Haus Montana is heated with renewable energy (pellet heating). Please do not heat the rooms to more than 20°-21°C (68° 69°F).
- Do not leave windows and the balcony door open when you leave the apartment, since the
 weather can change quickly, and storms are not uncommon in the Alps. Do also not leave
 windows and balcony door open for too long in the winter season months (period from
 October to April/May).
- Do not walk through the stairwell with your ski boots on. They must be put on and taken off in the ski room and stored there.
- No noise, loud music, loud TV or/and showering after 22:00h (10p.m.)!
- If something is broken, please let us know immediately, so that we can discuss the replacement together.

Please consider before leaving the apartment at the end of your stay:

- Dispose all your waste properly and follow the recycling rules (provided to you on the kitchen cabinet). Do not forget to empty the little trash bin in the bathroom.
- The grey waste bag must be tightly tied up and disposed into the metallic container outside Haus Montana on the other side of the road into the metallic container.
- Take all belongings with you check all drawers, the wardrobes, and the bathroom cabinet!
- Take off all bed linen and put them in the living room on the floor.
- Put all shower & hand towels, shower rug into the shower.
- Leave kitchen clean, dishes and silverware washed and tidied up, fridge must be emptied.
- Lock the door and deposit the key in the key depot next to the entrance door.
- If you like to use the washing machine during your stay, notify in advance.

→ It is mandatory to follow and consider the house rules of the "Haus Montana" and the general terms and conditions of the rental contract!













Children's and bedroom with a 140cm bed (lower mattress, max. 140kg) and a 90cm bed (above, max. 60kg)
